Disciplines: Competition of individuals in two disciplines.

IMI UZI - position "standing" at a distance of 50 m, target figure 135 P - reduced,

number of rounds 13 - rated 10 best.

Pistol CZ 75 – position "standing" at a distance of 25 m, target international

circles 50/20, number of rounds 13 - rated 10 best.

Weapons and ammunition are provided by the organizator.

Maximum 50 competitors

Entry fee: 300,- Kč / 12 €

General conditions:

Every shooter must be familiar with all the conditions of the competition specified in this terms and conditions, including the security measures that will be told to him / her when present. By signing the Presentation list he / her confirms the acknowledgment of all the conditions of the competition.

The use of hearing protectors is mandatory. Each participant in the competition is required to secure hearing protection by its own.

Photographing with a flash is forbidden during shooting.

Shooters must be persons over the age of 18. Childrens under the age of 14 are prohibited from entering the shooting range and youngsters aged over 14 may only move on the shooting range with a person aged 18 or over.

Shooters are prohibited from consuming alcoholic beverages or narcotics or stimulants before shooting.

Incorrect or dishonest behavior by competitors may result in disqualification. Persons who in any way interfere with the smooth running of the race will be expelled from the shooting range.

Only a competitor with a scorecard will be allowed to enter the firing line. The scorecard will be issued at the designated spot on the shooting range. The scorecard will only be issued to the registered person after paying the starting fee.

Entry to the firing range building and firing range is strictly forbidden and is punished by the disqualification of the competitor and expelling from the shooting range.

Parking of the participants' vehicles is possible near the area of the shooting range - marked with a sign.

During the competition and during the evaluation it is possible to buy snacks.

Weapons and ammunition:

IMI UZI - position "standing" at a distance of 50 m, target figure 135 P - reduced, number of rounds 13 - rated 10 best.

Pistol CZ 75 – position "standing" at a distance of 25 m, target international circles 50/20, number of rounds 13 - rated 10 best.

Every competitor has the following on the shooting line ready: weapon for current discipline, 1pc magazine and 13 rounds of ammunition.

Organisation of shooting:

The main shooting time is 5 min. for each discipline. The ammunition will be issued to the competitor before commencing the preparation. The competitor will be assigned the position on the firing line by the main referee. Throughout his presence on the firing line he follows all the judges' orders. After a discipline is shot, shooters will be called to the target where they will submit their scorecard to score points. The correctness of the entry is confirmed by shooters signature. After replacing the target, the contestants move back to the firing line and line up for the second discipline. Once the second discipline is shot, the competitors will move to the target again and write points with the main referee. Competitors who have all points from both disciplines leave the firing line.

A competitor will be not evaluated if he shoots any of the disciplines, but he will not turn in a completed and signed scorecard.

On the firing line are spotting scopes for checking of the hits on the target. Shooters checks their own hits, no one else is allowed to spot for them.

A competitor who finds supernumerary shots during shooting or immediately Supernumerary hits: after shooting, reports them immediately to the nearest referee on the firing line. If the referee recognizes that there are foreign supernumerary hits in the target, but is not to determine where they are, he will mark the hit with the lowest point value. Foreign supernumerary hits, which are marked by the referee, are not counted. If there are no marked supernumerary hits on the target, the best supernumerary hits will be crossed out, and then proceed with a normal scoring.

Check of the targets on the stands:

No one is allowed to enter the the space between the firing line and the targets without the referees permition. Target evaluation takes place after the end of the whole shift. The competitor is allowed visualy check his target. All shall obey the instructions of the referees and shall not touch any targets. The referee decides about the number of hits and multiple hits. The results of the targets are recorded on the scorecard of the competitor. After signing his scorecard, the shooter can not later post a protest.

Evaluation on each weapon separately:

When the points are the same from 1 to 10 place. Then decides the highest number of tens, nines, eights, ..

Evaluation for both weapons together:

When the points are the same from 1 to 10 place. Then decides the highest score from the pistol. If the points are still the same, the above decides.

Continuous score sheets will be posted in the shooting range area. The final score sheet will be posted after the results are counted for 30 minutes. Within two days the result sheet will be published on the website www.AVZO-cheb-mesto.cz

Safety precautions: On the firing line and in the shooting area, the SMOKING is forbidden.

Before and during the competition, competitors are prohibited from using

alcoholic beverages, drugs and doping substances.

Failure to comply with this provision must be a reason for disqualification.

Shooting Control:

Weapons can only be loaded on the firing line and only after the command "NABÍJET" (meaning the inserting of a loaded magazine in to the gun and putting a round into the chamber) or "START". In other cases, weapons must be empty and the slide open. When loading, the muzzle must be facing toward the target area. Magazines can be loaded with charges before "NABÍJET" command but the shooter must not touch the gun. During the shooting, the weapon may be laid down on the table only after removing the cartridge and the magazine and with slide opened. After the command "STOP" or "VYBÍT", the shooting must be stopped immediately, the shooters must unload their weapons and put them into a safe state. The shooting may only continue after the command "NABÍJET" or "START" has been re-issued.

A competitor who fired before the "CHOOSE" command or after a "DISABLE" command is unconditionally disqualified. A competitor who fired before "START" or after a "STOP" command can be disqualified. The primary duty of the shooter is: after the last shot, all shooters must make sure that there is no charge in the cartridge chamber or in the magazine before leaving the firing point, and this fact must be checked by the referee on the shotgun, the gun remaining on the table with the magazine removed and the open end. The weapons must not be manipulated if the operator is in front of the firing line, disrespecting must lead to disqualification.

Protests:

Protests may be filed to the Main referee no later than 30 minutes after the results are published on the shooting range. The protest can place every competitor on deposit of 500, - CZK.
